WELCOME

The Triple Crown Pole Futurity Program is an exciting new stallion program intended to showcase and identify superior Pole Bending Stallions, Jr. Stallions and the stallion's foals. Our purpose is to elevate the pole bending industry and to encourage breeding to the Triple Crown Pole Futurity stallions.

The NPBA Triple Crown Pole Futurity Program will have a series consisting of four shows with a NPBA Triple Crown Futurity class at each show for 4 and 5 year old horses nominated in the NPBA TC. Each of the four series classes will have \$500 added money to the class, plus a \$2500 side pot for NPBA members in good standing with a NPBA TC eligible horse in good standing. The sidepot payout will be a 3D format with 3 places being paid in the 1D - 2 places being paid in 2D and 2 places being paid in 3D.

An NPBA TC series award will be given to the top horse at the end of the NPBA TC 4 show series. To be eligible for the NPBA TC end of series award, the horse must be nominated in the NPBA TC futurity program and shown in 3 of the 4 shows. Only horses nominated in the NPBA Triple Crown Futurity will be eligible to participate.

Awards will also be given to NPBA TC top five stallions in 2020. In year 2020, the NPBA TC stallion awards will be capped at \$3000. The second year (2021), 60% of the NPBA Triple Crown Pole Futurity stallions will receive 80% of the stallion nomination money collected.

NPBA TRIPLE CROWN POLE FUTURITY (NPBA TC)

NPBA TRIPLE CROWN POLE FUTURITY SERIES SHOW RULES:

- The NPBA TC series will consist of 4 shows with a NPBA Triple Crown Pole Futurity Class.
- Each of the NPBA TC 4 shows class will have \$500 added with a \$2500 sidepot for NPBA members in good standing riding a horse nominated if the NPBA TC.
- The sidepot payout will be a 3D format with 3 places being paid in 1D – 2 places being paid in 2D – 2 places being paid in 3D. The NPBA member in good standing riding an eligible NPBA TC horse in good standing and having the fastest time of the class is the 1st place winner of the sidepot at each of the NPBA TC series show class.
- The NPBA TC will use a progressive payback of 27% - 22% - 17% in first division; 12% - 9% in second division and 7% - 6% for third division.
- Shows consists of the NPBA National Championship show in June; the NPBA Super Show in September; the Kissmas show in December, and another show to be determined.

NPBA TRIPLE CROWN POLE FUTURITY SERIES YEAR END AWARD RULES:

- At the end of the NPBA TC futurity 4 show series, the triple crown award will be given to the owner of the high point NPBA TC horse.
- Must be an NPBA TC nominated horse in good standing, ridden by a NPBA member in good standing and had been shown in 3 of the 4 series shows.
- Each nominee's 3 fastest times will be combined to crown the NPBA TC year end champion.
- Only horses nominated in the NPBA Triple Crown Futurity will be eligible to participate and the horse must be in good standing in the NPBA TC.

NPBA TRIPLE CROWN POLE FUTURITY YEAR END STALLION AWARD RULES:

- Year end awards will be given to the top 5 stallions in the 2020 TC series.
- Cumulative points will be recorded from the sire's foal's winners from the 4 TC series shows class.
- Five set of points will be given from each show as follows: 5pts to first place – 4 pts. to second place – 3 pts. to third place – 2 pts. for fourth place – 1 pt. for fifth place
- A NPBA TC stallion will only receive points in one placing per show.
- 2020 NPBA TC stallion awards will be capped at \$3000 with 1st place receiving \$800; 2nd place receiving \$700; 3rd place receiving \$600; 4th place receiving \$500 and 5th place receiving \$400.
- Ties will be determined by the NPBA TC stallion nominee with the fastest time.
- The NPBA member in good standing riding an eligible NPBA TC horse in good standing and having the fastest time of the class is the 1st place winner of the sidepot at each of the NPBA TC series show class.
- 2021 the top 60% of the NPBA TC stallions will receive 80% of the NPBA TC stallion nomination fee collected.

FOAL NOMINATION RULES:

1. NPBA TC reserves the right to refuse any foal nomination.
2. A foal of a NPBA TC stallion in good standing may be nominated into the NPBA TC at the age of a yearling up to a 5 year old.
3. The foal owner must be a NPBA member is good standing at the time of nomination and throughout the NPBA TC series.
4. A foal nominator must be the registered owner of the foal at the time of nomination. If a foal changes ownership, a NPBA TC change of ownership form must be submitted to the NPBA office.
5. A copy of the foal's registration papers must accompany the NPBA TC nomination form.
6. Only foals of a nominated stallion in good standing can be nominated in the NPBA TC Futurity Program.
7. All NPBA TC side pot checks will be mailed. **NO REFUNDS** of foal's nomination payments.
8. Any disputes arising from misinterpretation of any rules or conditions of the NPBA TC shall be decided by the NPBA Board of Directors.
9. NPBA Board of Directors reserves the right to alter the conditions of all or part of the NPBA TC.

FOAL NOMINATION FEES: (Foals age as of January 1st every year) **LATE FEES ARE CUMULATIVE.**

EXP: If a foal is not nominated until a 4 year old, the fee will be \$100 plus a late fee of \$100 from yearling year, \$100 for 2 year old year and \$100 from 3 year old year for a total of \$700.

Yearling – Upfront payment of \$400 (Payment due by Nov. 1 or a \$50 late fee. After Dec. 1, a late fee of \$100)
Yearly payments -- \$100 the first year -- \$100 the second year -- \$200 the third year
If making yearly payments, payment due by Nov. 1 of current year or a \$50 late fee. After Dec. 1, a late fee of \$100

2 year old – Upfront payment of \$400 (Payment due by Nov. 1 or a \$50 late fee. After Dec. 1, a late fee of \$100)
\$200 the first year and \$200 the second year
If making yearly payments, payment due by Nov. 1 of current year or a \$50 late fee. After Dec. 1, a late fee of \$100

3 and 4 year old – Payment of \$400 due by March 1st of current year or a late fee of \$50. Full payment due by April 1 of current year to run in the June NPBA TCPFP class at the National Champion Show. No nominations accepted after May 1 of current year.

5 year old – Upfront payment of \$200 due by March 1 of current year or a late fee of \$50. Full payment due by April 1 of current year to run in the June NPBA TC Class at the NPBA National Champion Show. No nominations accepted after April 1 of current year.
