Grounds Fee \$7 per horse. No grounds fee for PeeWee riders. PeeWee riders must be 8 & under as of January 1, 2022 and cannot ride in any other class. All classes payback 70% and must have a minimum of 10 horses for added money to apply. 3D classes switch to 4D with 75 entries. All NBHA sanctioned classes include a \$3 awards fee. All NPBA sanctioned classes include a \$2 awards fee. Roll Overs: Are allowed from Open NBHA class to Youth, Adult or Senior NBHA class. RO's are to be done at the FULL entry fee price. RO's must be done before Open Barrels begins.
